36. Pinot Noir, Escarpment 'The Edge', Martinborough NZ
Ripe cherry and plum flavours. Top value Pinot from the master Larry 'McPinot' McKenna.

37. Roboul, D. Danjou-Banessy, AOC Côtes du Roussillon Villages. 50/50 blend of old Mourvèdre and Grenache vines that are organically farmed on clay and limestone soils. Stunning.

38. Château du Courneau 2014 Margaux, Bordeaux
Intense colour, refined red fruits, vanilla notes and a power combined with a great freshness.

39. Cuvée 42 2015, Domaine des Trinités, Faugères AOC
Biodynamic, whole-bunch fermented in open top barrels - The Coulsh's oldest vineyards Grenache and Carignan. Full bodied, rich, spicy black fruits. Hedonistic and luscious. Please try!

40. Villa Mon Réve 2013, D. Gayda AOP Minervois la Livinière
100% Syrah. The wine Vincent Chansault (lover of Northern Rhône wines) dreamt of producing. A top wine of the appellation. Complex wihreal structure. Wonderful.

Rosé Wines

41. Cette Nuit, Pays d'Oc
Pale pink, thirst quenching, pretty, classic southern French.

42. D. Combe Blanche, Calamiac Terroir Minervois AOC
This delicately pink, fragrant dry rosé is made exclusively for Cambscuisine by Guy Vanlancker of Domaine Combe Blanche from Cinsault & Grenache grapes grown on the slopes of the Black Mountains. We are very happy with this beauty from a master vigneron of the Languedoc.



Sparkling Wines

43. Prosecco Spumante Extra Dry Le Calle DOC
Good, fun fizz.

44. Rosé Crémant de Limoux, Émotion, Antech, Limoux
Utterly charming and elegant pink fizz.

45. Chapel Down Classic Brut NV, England
Elegant; aromas of apple, lemongrass and freshly baked bread with fine persistent bubbles. Top value English sparkling wine.

46. Champagne, Joseph Perrier Cuvée Royale Brut NV
One of few wines on the list not from the Languedoc. The epitome of Joseph's style.

Dessert Wines

47. Muscat de Rivesaltes, Domaine Treloar
Côtes du Roussillon, France. A late harvested fortified sweet dessert wine with a rich, honeyed palate.

48. Banyuls Traditionnel Robert Pages AOCVdN
90% Grenache Noir, 10% Grenache Gris. A traditional Banyuls - sweet, complex and marvellous. Served chilled.

49. Maury Rouge, Domaine des Soulanes, Maury AOC
From a single vineyard of old vine Grenache. This vintage port style is deeply fruited, well structured and extremely satisfying! Only made in the best years.

As the largest wine growing area in the world, the Languedoc-Roussillon is able to provide a diversity of terroir (geology, geography and climate), allowing us to source a wide range of wines from this one area alone.
